Duties of Preschool Teacher

General Duties:

- Guides children in the proper and safe use of facilities and equipment
- Follows toilet training guidelines, and ensures all children are cared for in a sanitary and safe manner
- Communicates regularly and effectively (and in a confidential manner when necessary) with parents and caregivers in a manner that fosters a team-like atmosphere and the best learning environment for children
- Encourages children to care for and put away toys, books, and other materials
- Assists in planning and execution of child assessments, portfolio for parents, and fundraisers
- Complies with Ohio Licensing Rules
- Other duties as required.

- Plans and implements curriculum appropriate for preschool-aged children, including Christian curriculum
- Works positively with other teachers to align curriculum and serve the wellbeing of students
- Leads children daily in developmentally appropriate activities, including centers, art, dramatic play, and large group singing, reading, and/or games
- Arranges and takes part in indoor play

Classroom Environment Responsibilities

- Assesses room/play areas daily to ensure all toys and equipment are safe and clean
- Sets up classroom daily, making sure supplies are ready for activities
- Organizes and sanitizes classroom daily after children depart.

Spiritual Qualities

- Professes Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior
- Exhibits commitment to personal spiritual growth and healthy lifestyle
- Considers this position a ministry
- Models standards and expectations of staff members within Shiloh Church, including faithfully serving out of your calling and giftedness.

Education

- High school diploma or equivalent is required
